They may also be involved in other Eurojust activities (College plenary meetings, strategic meetings, coordination meetings and team meetings).	Participants will be integrated in Cabinets of Members of the Court. Their tasks will vary according to the needs of each Member but they will mainly be called upon to assist Members in dealing with files they will be in charge with. They will not attend the deliberations of the different ruling bodies.	Participants will be included in the Court's Registry and they will mainly deal with the individual applications relating to the system of their national country. More particularly, they will be in charge of dealing with applications to be rejected by the Court for non compliance with the conditions of admissibility. They will attend Court sessions and may introduce applications.
